



CITROËN SELECT APPROVED USED 12-MONTH WARRANTY

CITROËN SELECT APPROVED USED vehicles have dealer-provided warranty against any defect during a period of 12-months, dating from the day of delivery of the **CITROËN SELECT APPROVED USED** vehicle to the customer.

This warranty does not affect the statutory rights of the owner of the vehicle. This warranty covers:

- The repair or replacement of components recognised as defective
- The labour required for this repair or replacement

Application of the **CITROËN SELECT APPROVED USED 12-MONTH WARRANTY** is dependent on strict adherence to the periodic maintenance as detailed in the vehicle's Maintenance Guide, evidence of this being the servicing certificates completed in the Maintenance Guide.

The work carried out under this warranty must be undertaken by a Citroën Authorised Repairer. Replaced parts which are subject to a warranty claim may be required to be sent to the manufacturer for technical examination. If the warranty claim is accepted, defective components will become the property of the manufacturer. If the warranty claim is rejected, the parts can be returned to the customer, if requested in advance. The replacement or repair of a component under warranty does not prolong the period of warranty of the vehicle. This warranty does not cover:

- Routine maintenance operations and inspections, including adjustments and alignments
- Paintwork
- Windscreens
- Tyres
- Consequences of abnormal use of the vehicle, human error or negligence
- Consequences of the fitting on the vehicle of parts that are not approved by the manufacturer
- Damage resulting from natural causes or from accidents
- Consequences of repairs, conversions or modifications carried out by organisations not approved by the manufacturer
- Damage which has resulted from a failure to arrange for an obvious fault to be corrected
- Wear and Tear – parts that need to be changed because they are showing signs of wear or tear, or are worn and at the end of their normal operating life, which can vary depending on the use of the vehicle, its mileage, and the geographical and climatic environment, and where replacement is not the consequence of a malfunction. This includes in particular but not exclusively the following parts:

- Front and rear brake discs and pads
- Rear brake shoes
- Clutches including release bearing, pressure plates and centre plate
- Accessory drive belts
- Front and rear dampers
- Vehicle batteries and dry cell batteries
- Spark plugs
- Light bulbs and fuses
- Filters (except FAP)
- Textiles including floor carpet, seat cushion, back rest, armrest and headrest cover
- Glass
- Wiper blades
- Lower arm ball joints
- Anti-roll bar drop links
- Track rod ends

This list is not exhaustive and can be amended by the manufacturer, without notice, at any time. Where wear and tear of parts causes consequential damage to other parts, repair or replacement of those other parts is also outside the scope of this warranty.
